#### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Frontiers International is a national, nonprofit, nonsectarian, service organization. Its members include men and women from all segments of society that are professional, business, religious, political, educational and civic leaders. Each member participates in several hours of volunteer activities designed to improve the lives of disadvantaged students and residents of historically underserved communities. Consequently, the organization has developed several programs to achieve these goals, including this Scholarship Program.

A. <u>Purpose</u>: To assist graduating high school seniors in achieving post-secondary educational opportunities. It is our hope that recipients of this grant will utilize their education, knowledge and wisdom to become leaders of tomorrow. More importantly, this program will provide financial assistance to individuals that have demonstrated academic promise, but financial barriers may prevent these individuals from pursuing their dreams. Applicants can apply for the scholarship to attend a two-year or four-year trade school, college or university. <u>No scholarship will be awarded if the institution is not accredited or does not offer a certificate or degree</u>. A successful applicant may apply each year while attending school while maintaining a minimum 2.0 grade point average.

This year the organization is planning to award a \$1,000 scholarship, with the <u>potential</u> for \$4,000 over four years, to worthy and deserving senior high school students who will be graduating this coming June. An initial payment of \$500 will be awarded at the beginning of the student's first semester. The additional \$500 payment will be received subsequent to the Club receiving the student's 1<sup>st</sup> semester transcript verifying the student has maintained a 2.0 grade point average, continued enrollment and the address to which the check may be mailed.

#### B. <u>Eligibility Requirements</u>: All applicants must submit the following materials:

- 1. A completed application
- 2. Most recent (official) high school transcript forwarded by your high school
- 3. Essay of 1000 1500 words
- 4. \* Acceptance letter from the college the applicant intends to attend
- 5. Letter of Recommendation (An adult familiar with the applicants academic / non-academic activities including work, community service and/or leadership activities)
- 6. \* Demonstrated financial need University balance due
- 7. Photo of self wallet size
- 8. Received by no later than the **second Wednesday in May**

# Note: Relatives are not eligible to write either academic or community recommendations.

Review the application to ensure that you have answered each question. If the question does not apply enter N/A for not applicable.

**C.** <u>Deadline</u>: The application must be completed in a neat and legible package with a color photo of self, and postmarked no later than the second **Monday in May.** An application is considered completed if all the "required" materials in **SECTION D** accompany the application at the time it is mailed. (can be hand delivered by member by deadline).

FIRST SEMESTER	Payment of 50% of scholarship award, upon verification of registration as a full time 1 <sup>st</sup> semester student, and forwarding address where the check shall be mailed.
SECOND SEMESTER	Remaining 50% payment of 1st year scholarship will be given at the beginning of the second semester based on recipient receiving a 1st semester "2.0" grade point; current semester verification of full-time student registration and address where the check shall be mailed.
SUBSEQUENT SEMESTERS  **** IMPORTANT ****	Scholarship awards may be granted at the beginning of each semester based on the recipient receiving a prior semester "2.0" grade point average, verification of current semester full-time registration and forwarding address in which to forward the check.
